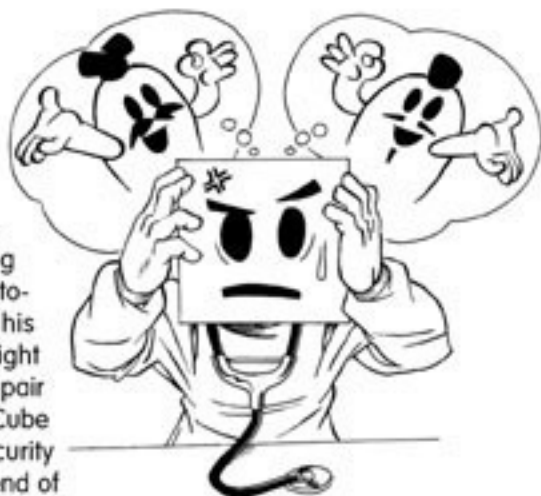

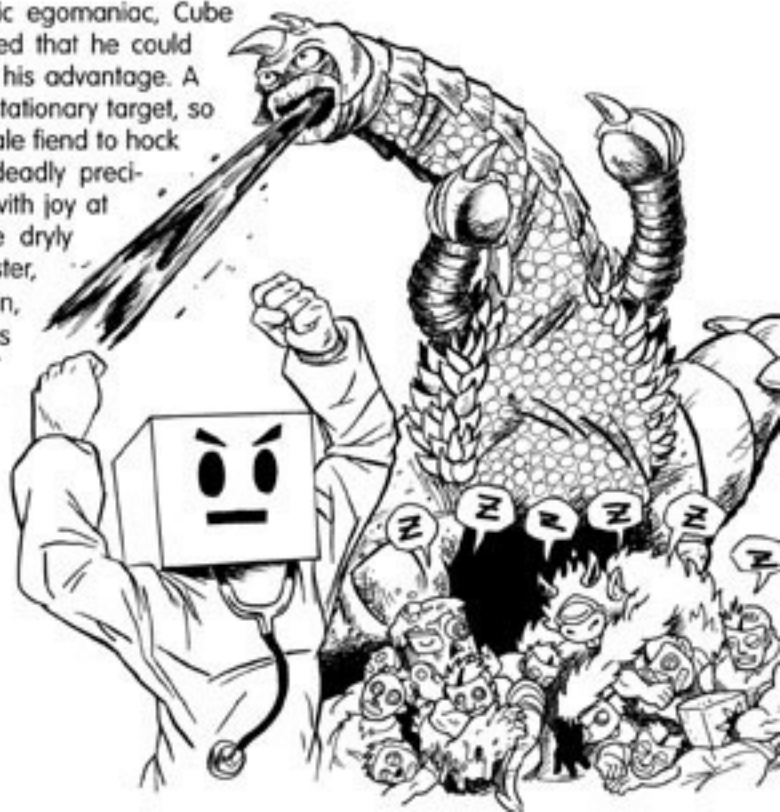

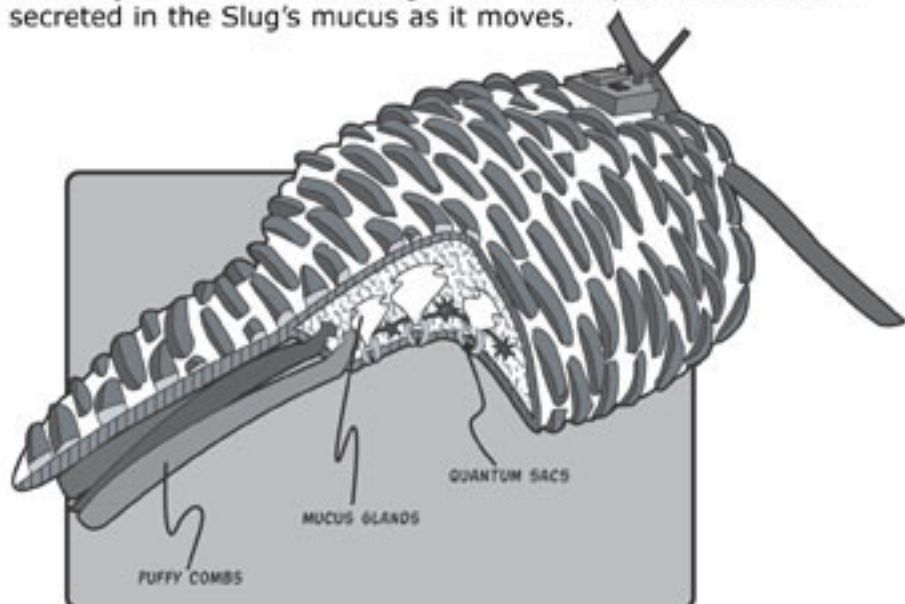
## How SDS-1 Travels through Space & Time

The world's greatest minds have called SDS-1's super-dimensional travel a brilliant, elegant process. The rest of the world's not-so-great minds have labeled it a headache-inducing enigma. For those of you in the second group, we will now explain the workings of SDS-1 in simple terms. For those in the first group, please skip to the next section.

The key to SDS-1's time travel lies in the Slug's bioengineered secretions. All normal, garden-variety slugs produce mucus that aids their locomotion — as a slug moves, it leaves a trail of mucus behind. SDS-1 secretes mucus in the same fashion. However, thanks to the genetic manipulations of Nazi scientists, SDS-1's mucus contains an additional ingredient: quantum particles.

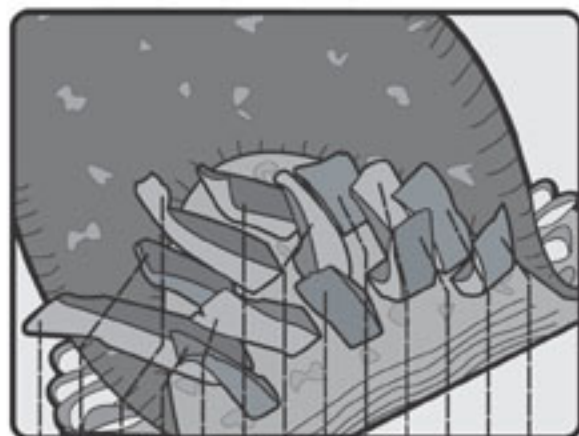
While it is unclear how the Third Reich's scientists were able to induce the creation of quantum particles in SDS-1, this much is certain: they are essential to his super-dimensional manipulations. Utilizing a series of chemically-coated combs on his posterior, SDS-1 initiates reactions that harness the power of these quantum particles to manipulate any and all dimensions. This process is illustrated in the following example.

**Step 1:** SDS-1 generates quantum particles in sacs located just below its mucus glands. These particles are then secreted in the Slug's mucus as it moves.

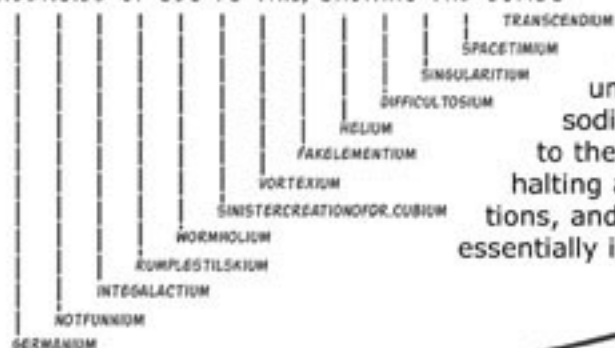


HOW SDS-1 TRAVELS THROUGH SPACE & TIME USING ITS OWN SECRETIONS

**Step 2:** As SDS-1 moves across its mucus trail, the gastropod activates different combinations of thirteen bright-red combs under its tail. Each comb is infused with a different element. By varying the combs selected, SDS-1 chooses which dimensions to manipulate and what degree they're manipulated.

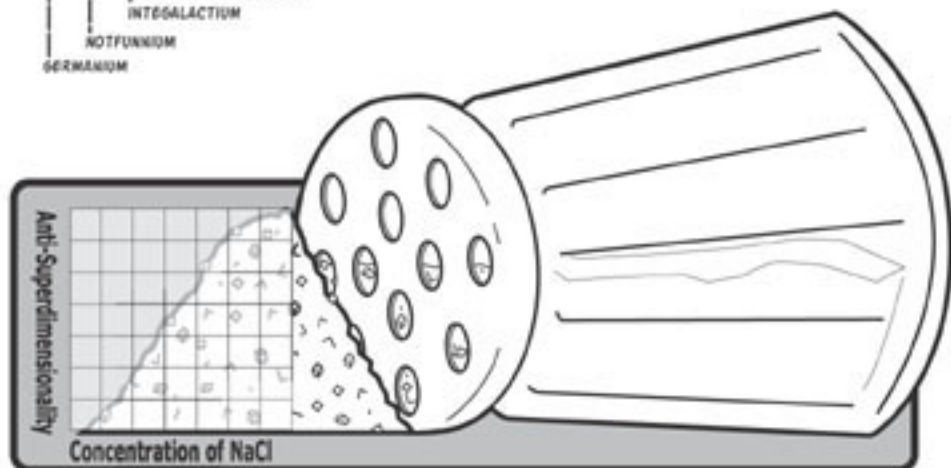


UNDERSIDE OF SDS-1'S TAIL, SHOWING THE COMBS



**Step 3:** With the combs in place, a super-dimensional reaction occurs: time and space bend to SDS-1's iron will. Once SDS-1 disengages the combs, the chemical reaction halts, ending the dimensional manipulations. Throughout the entire process, the only thing capable of interfering

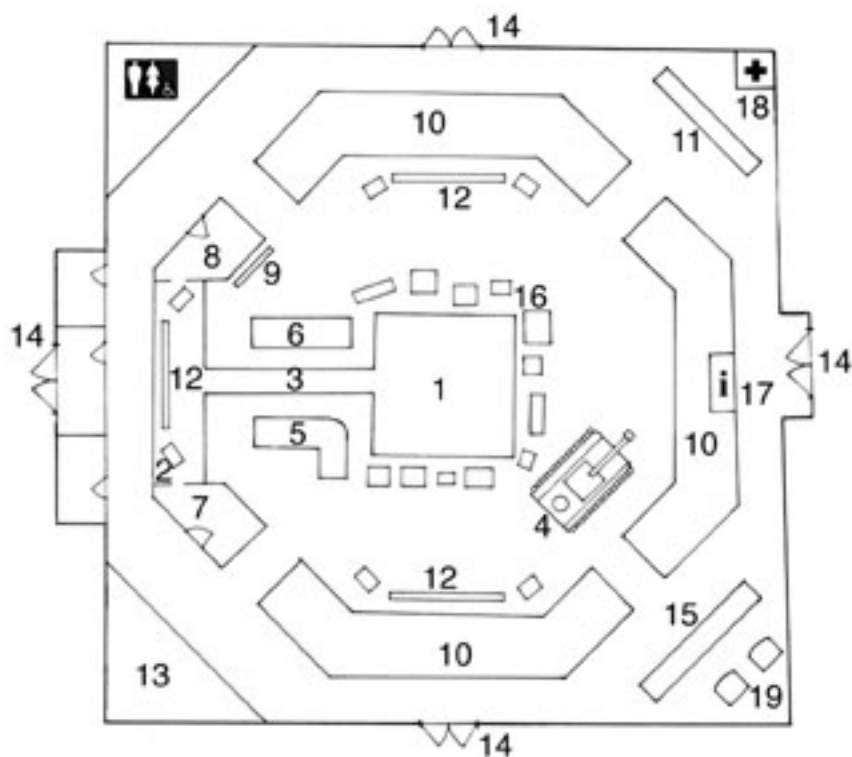
with the Slug's operation is sodium. When present, sodium atoms will bind to the quantum particles halting all chemical reactions, and leaving SDS-1 essentially immobile.
